

# DON'T LET YOUR DOG FEEL THE BURN...



If a dog is out during peak sun exposure hours, reapply sunscreen to the sun-sensitive areas of the body throughout the day:



Nose



Around the lips



Tips of the ears



Groin and belly



Always immediately reapply sunscreen after swimming.

## WHAT TYPE OF SUNSCREEN?


Sunscreen created specifically for canine use is the safest and most effective, but if you don't have pet sunscreen, look for a broad-spectrum sunscreen for babies and children with an SPF of 15 or higher—but read the label!



**Sunscreen should not contain:**

- Fragrance
- Zinc oxide
- Para-aminobenzoic acid (PABA)

## OTHER PRECAUTIONS:



Bodysuits or shirts



Hats with ultraviolet protection



Dog goggles



The best protection is sun avoidance, keeping pets out of the sun, especially between the peak sun hours of 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.
